### **Board Takes Action**

At the July Board Meeting your directors received a briefing from Senator Bennett's office and board members of the Western Colorado Latino Chamber regarding the federal immigration bill. While the Latino Chamber does not take position on issues the Grand Junction Chamber was urged to vote to support the measure by those present. The Governmental Affairs Committee will take up the issue at its August meeting.

In other action, the board voted to send a letter of support on behalf of Fram's request to drill exploratory wells on BLM land, received a midyear report on accomplishments and finances from staff and approved a budget adjustment to increase the hours of the Governmental Affairs Manager to full time in order to assist the Mesa County Business Education Foundation.


